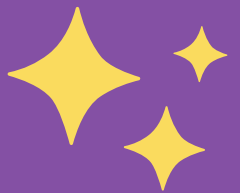

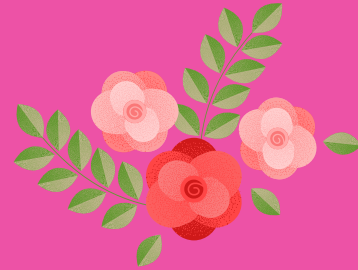

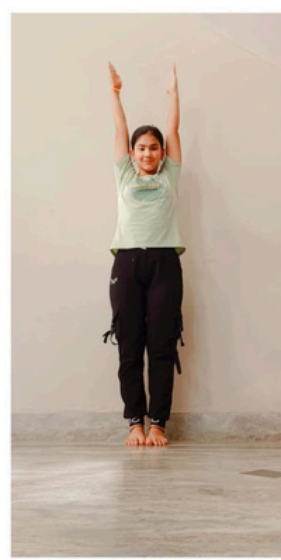
Yoga Day

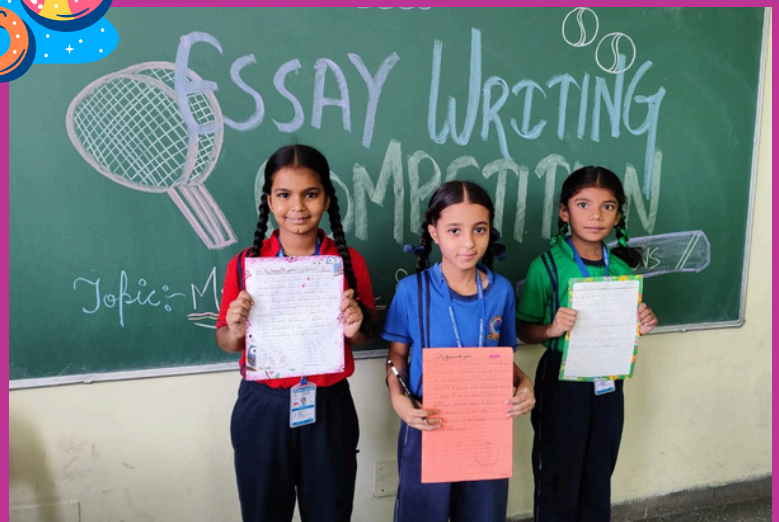




"Writing is an exploration. You start from nothing and learn as you go."

Raahgiri Programme



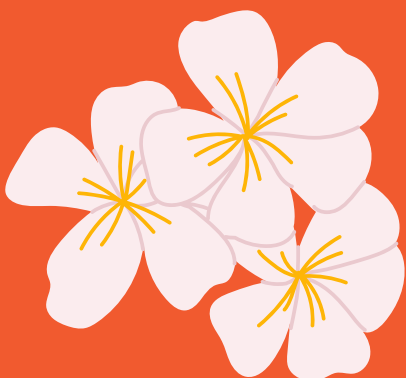

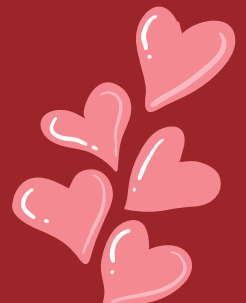
