



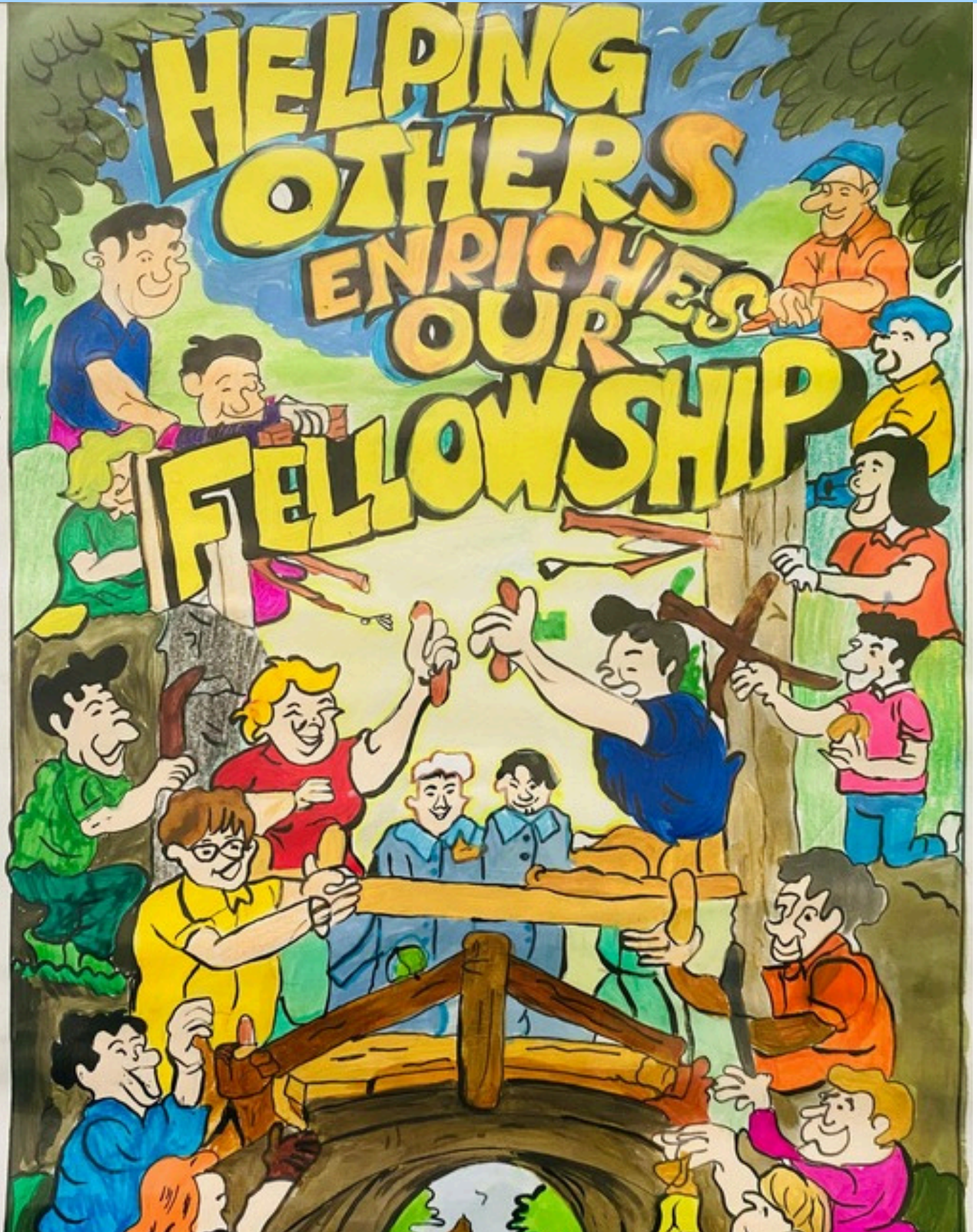

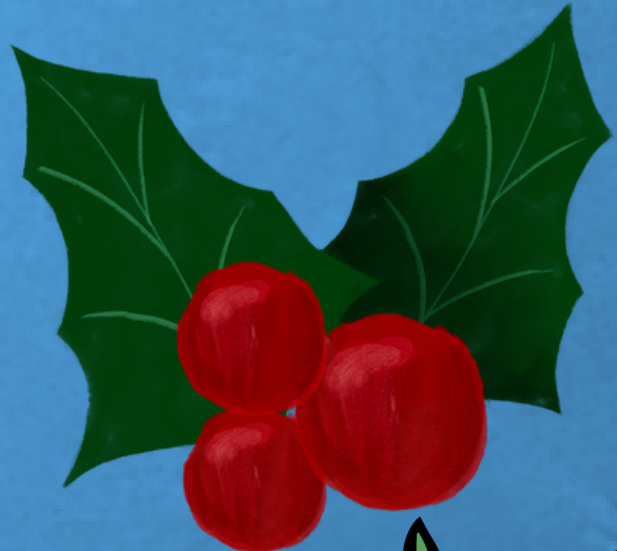


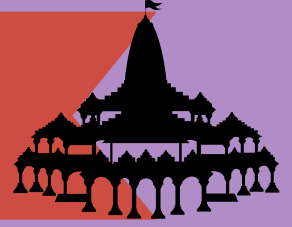
On 23rd December 2025, the Kindergarten students visited a nearby Church on the joyful occasion of Christmas.

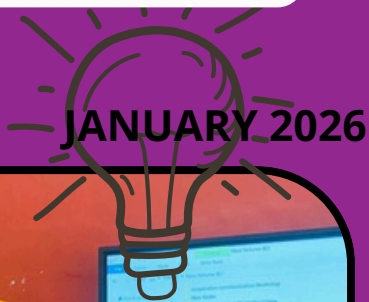

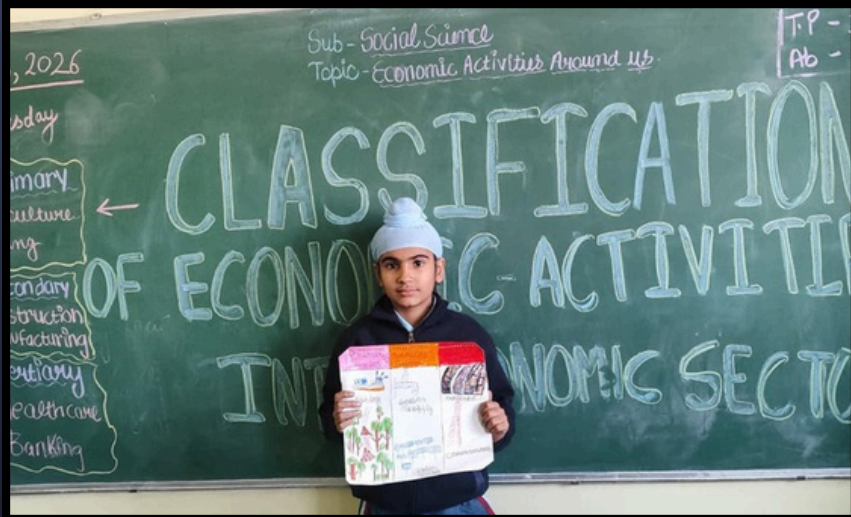




CLASSIFICATION OF ECONOMIC ACTIVITY

FEBRUARY 2026

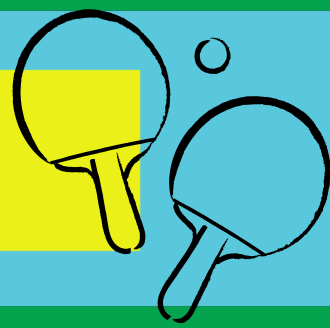

Roti Bank Initiative

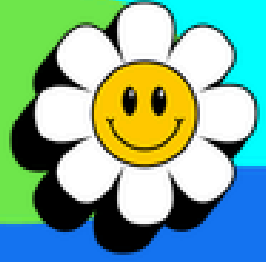


Students actively participated in the Roti Bank Initiative with great enthusiasm. They brought chapatis from home along with vegetables to support the needy.

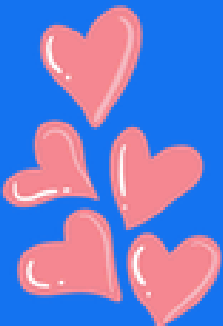

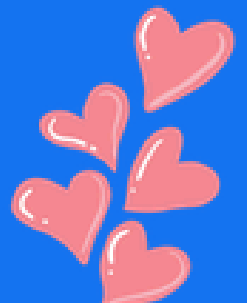

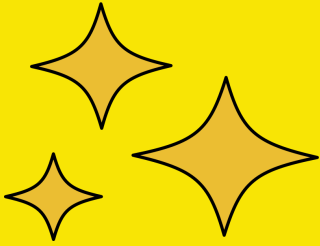
